Taking the Good News to the Schools in Brentwood...

For more than 15 years the Trust has been developing a Christian presence in our Schools in Brentwood. We aim to provide support, from our strongly Christian ethos, for the spiritual and moral development of school age children.

We do this by a variety of means such as:

- Assemblies (presenting Christianity in thought-provoking and relevant ways);
- Lessons (teaching Christianity and Christian values in RE, PSHE and other lessons);
- Groups (exploring Christian life in Christian Unions and Bible-based clubs);
- Supporting children in the transition from Primary to Secondary school through the 'Moving on' project;
- Establishing a Chaplaincy initiative with one of the town's Secondary schools covering all the year groups in the school;
- Support (supporting school pupils and staff pastorally in informal and formal ways).

In any week in the School year the Trust is providing, through its four part time staff and its 20+ volunteers, up to 35 different activities in the town's schools. In all these activities the Trust aims to act as bridge between the churches in the town and the schools which are closely located to them.

One of our Management Committee members recently described what we do in these words:

"As a gardener you will know that patience is required once seeds have been sown. Sometimes it takes a long time to see results. It is the same at the Brentwood Schools Christian Worker Trust. However, the seeds still have to be sown. **Would you be a sower of seeds?** Not in the actual physical sense, but in contributing to a packet of seed in the shape of a schools worker who goes into the local schools to share the Good News of the Christian faith?"
